High School

- Monthly opportunities to be involved in community work.
- Perfect attendance will exempt students from final day of classes each semester.
- Exempt from final if grade is 96% with three or fewer absences.

Alternative School

- Monthly opportunities to be involved in
- community work.

Dropout Indicators

Elementary

- ✘ After 10 absences in Kindergarten through 6th grade, students do not master needed content knowledge.
- ✘ Poor reading performance by third grade.
- ✘ Retention in any grade.

Middle School

- ✘ Earning an "F" in English or Math.
- ✘ Missing five days of class.

High School

- ✘ One or more failing grades.
- ✘ Missing five days of class.
- ✘ Grade point average of 2.0 or less on a 4.0 scale.



Consequences

Kindergarten through 8th

- Parents/guardians will be asked to conference with principal after five unexcused absences.

High School

- Attendance at after-school study hall.
- Saturday school
- Teacher/PLC contact
- Referral to juvenile system of Division of Family Services if absences continue.
